announces a competition for the position of **ADJUNCT**
in the Genetics and Marine Biotechnology Department

The competition may be entered by persons who meet the requirements for the position of ADJUNCT defined in the Act of 30 April 2010 of the Polish Academy of Sciences, and have:

- Ph.D. in the field of agricultural sciences, range of fisheries, fish genetics;
- knowledge in the fish physiology, including physiological mechanisms of stress response in fish;
- documented authorship and co-authorship of publications in JCR journals scientific achievements in the field of cytogenetic research of fish;
- knowledge of laboratory molecular biology techniques: PCR, PCR-RFLP, Real-Time PCR, analysis of gene expression by RT-qPCR method confirmed by professional experience and participation in specialized trainings;
- knowledge of DNA and RNA extraction and purification techniques;
- knowledge of specialized computer software used in data analysis from molecular biology experiments as well as allowing to perform *in silico* tests;
- knowledge of classical and molecular (FISH) cytogenetic techniques
- good communication skills and ability to work in an interdisciplinary team;
- very good knowledge of Polish and English (confirmed by a certificate).
